



Route to a LISS/CSCS Smartcard

If you require a new CSCS card or your current CSCS card has expired follow this flowchart. This process will not happen overnight. Allow 6-8 weeks to complete the full process.

ATTEND a one day ROLO (Register of Landscape operatives) Health and Safety Awareness Course and **PASS** the multiple choice exam. This can be arranged with the Arboricultural Association (www.trees.org.uk).

You will be issued with a certificate for successfully completing and passing the course.

Green Card – Basic Operative

Red Card – Trainee

Blue Card – Skilled Operative

Gold Card – Supervisor

Black Card – Manager

TAKE and **PASS** the CSCS Health and Safety 'Touch Screen' Test. You will be given proof of passing the test immediately.
