

Level 2 Certificate in Arboriculture September 2020 Intake

Pre-requisites: it is strongly recommended that applicants are already practicing arborists or gain experience within the arboricultural industry during their year of study.

Awarding body: ABC Awards.

Assessment type: Portfolio of evidence.

Venue: Tree Life Training Centre in Syston, Leicestershire.

Length of course: approximately 1 year within a traditional academic term timetable. This will be in the form of 11 sessions running from 9.30am to 4.30pm on a Monday, with additional online portal guidance.

Support is continued for a further year. Moderation will occur 1 year after the course starts.
