

Level 4 Diploma in Arboriculture September 2020 Intake

Pre-requisites: Ideally candidates will have a level 2 Certificate in Arboriculture or an equivalent qualification along with relevant experience.

Awarding body: ABC Awards. Assessment type: Portfolio of evidence.

Venues:

- Westonbirt Arboretum, Tetbury in Gloucestershire
- Tree Life Training Centre in Syston, Leicestershire
- Harlow Centre: Tim Moya Associates in Harlow, Essex (New for 2020!)

Length of course: approximately 1 year within a traditional academic term timetable. This will be in the form of 15 full day sessions plus additional online portal guidance.

Support is continued for a further year and a third year of support is available. Moderation will occur 1 year after the course starts.

- 1. Pest, disease and disorder identification
- 2. Tree biomechanics and maintenance
- 3. Tree development and protection
- 4. Woody vegetation formation and physiology
- 5. Principles of tree management

- 6. Selection, planting and design with hardy nursery stock for amenity and landscape purposes
- 7. Principles of woodland establishment and management
- 8. Tree related damage to built structure
