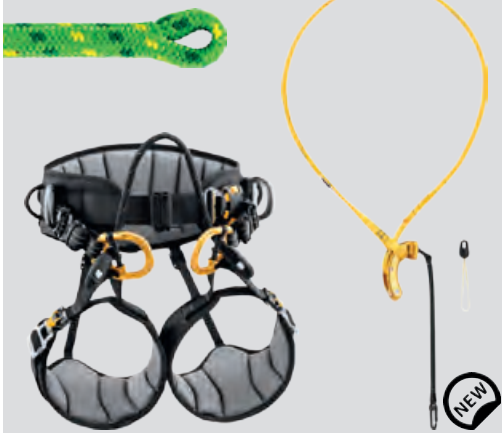

# ARB SHOW OPEN CLIMBING COMPETITION

SPONSORED BY HARKIE



Last year over 35 climbers competed in the UK Open sponsored by Harkie; the first ever climbing competition to be held at an APF show. This year there are some fantastic prizes to be won thanks to our ARB Show Open sponsors Harkie, who will also be on hand supporting our competitors.

**10:00-16:00** each day at the ARB Show entrance path

The ARB Show Open climbing competitions are run by a group of passionate and dedicated volunteer arborists who want to help advance tree climbing practice and safety in the UK. Many of the Rules are designed to simulate some of the real-life work scenarios which climbing arborists encounter. The two trees will be laid out to simulate a work-climb scenario with a number of canopy tasks to carry out during the climb. Boel Hammarstrand is the ARB Show Open Head Judge and has finished third in the International Tree Climbing World Championships and first in the Swedish Tree Climbing Championships.



*"We try to encourage safe working practices. Speed isn't everything; it's more important to be safe and good at what you do than to be the fastest climber. It's better to go slow and steady than to go crashing through the tree; if you break lots of small branches you are going to get penalised because its not good for the tree and it's not good climbing practice. We put emphasis on things like storing your lanyard and making sure your lines are secured."*

Bo has been a competition climber since 2008, but in her experience, these events aren't just about competing: *"My favourite part of the competitions is meeting people, catching up with old friends, making new ones and of course climbing trees and sharing*

*knowledge. It's all about encouraging people to climb trees. It's a friendly environment; if you're struggling with your climb people will help you, give you tips and make you feel comfortable. It's about getting together and having fun climbing trees."*

There are three categories – Premier climbers start from the ground and are expected to carry out an audible visual and site assessment before they start their ascent into the canopy. Expert and Novice climbers have the luxury of starting from the top of the tree and being able to catch their breath before starting the competition.

The ARB Show Open rules have been designed to be as transparent as possible and simple to follow. Before attempting any task, they should give a clear audible warning simulating a working environment by making colleagues aware of an enhanced risk. When climbers move between stations the judges are looking for the main lifeline to be maintained at an acceptable tension (no slack) to avoid overloading the system if a fall were to occur. Competitors are penalised for faults such as failure to secure themselves or to give a warning and for slips falls and slack line whilst climbing. At three target areas they can gain valuable time bonuses.

## COMPETITION RULES OVERVIEW

**The ARB Show Open Climbing Competition tests the contestants ability to climb and move about the tree using methods that comply with industry guidance Technical Guide 1. So, prior to leaving the ground, and at all times whilst aloft, competitors must be attached to a primary system and backup system.**

The event setup is the same for both men and women. There are three categories, based on their current level of experience and skill, which climbers can enter. Competitors in the Novice (a recommended level for students and less experienced climbers) and Expert category will all start from the top anchor point. Premier category climbers will start from the ground.

Based on their category competitors are required to visit a number of targets as set out by the head Judge these target areas may include a number of target zones and stations as described below to perform a specified task at each station or zone. Canopy stations or zones in the tree will be equipped with a bell; the contestant must ring the bell before continuing to the next station.

Contestants score points for successfully completing the task at each station and ringing the bell. At work stations the competitor will be required to lanyard in securely. View the full rules at the competition site or the links in this article for detail on individual work stations and further information.

At some work stations, the contestant can earn bonus time points for completing additional tasks. However, time penalties are added when a contestant fails to properly complete a task, or when uncontrolled or unsafe practices are observed (see score sheet). The stations can be completed in any order the climber chooses.



## KEY CHANGES TO COMPETITION RULES SINCE 2019

### 2.2.13A

All activities aloft including the Work Climb event must be done with the aid of a work-positioning or fall-protection system, including a backup system.

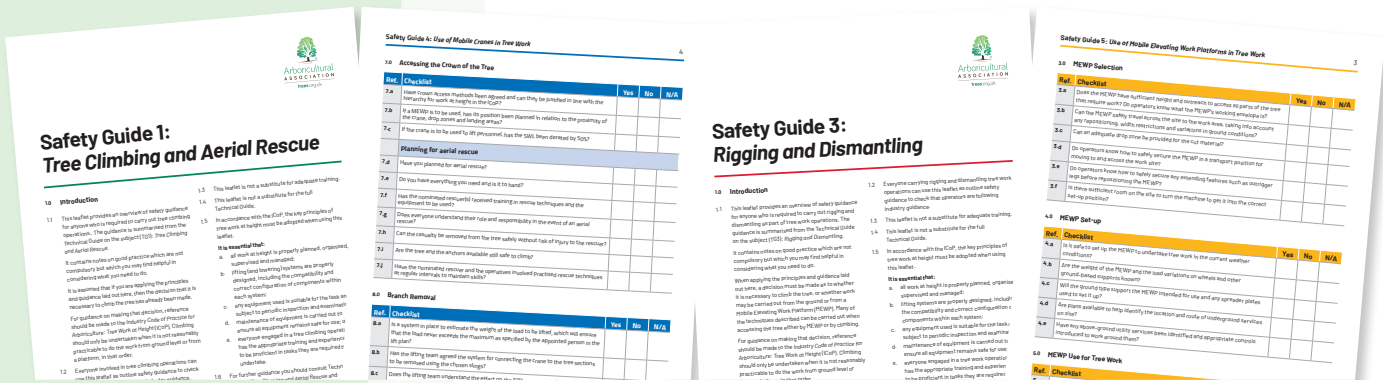
### 2.2.5A

All personal climbing equipment is now subject to a detailed pre-inspection by the competitor in advance of the event. This pre-inspection is to be registered on the new kit check forms which must be submitted along with your equipment for inspection by the judging team. NOTE: The kit check form now forms the event scoring section of these events you will receive time penalties for submitting substandard or unsuitable equipment, as well as time penalties for submitting substandard (illegible) or incomplete forms. (see section 3.a1)

### 2.2.34B

Steel core lanyards are no longer deemed acceptable for use as secondary anchor points in the ARB Show Open competition. (Following several high-profile failures relating to steel core lanyards their questionable suitability for use in tight bend radius scenarios and the difficulty in inspecting the core and crimps for signs of wear the judging team have decided to decline their future use in ARB Show Open events. Our decision relates to the ARB Show Open events alone, wider industrial and training use of steel core lanyards should be considered by the individuals concerned.)

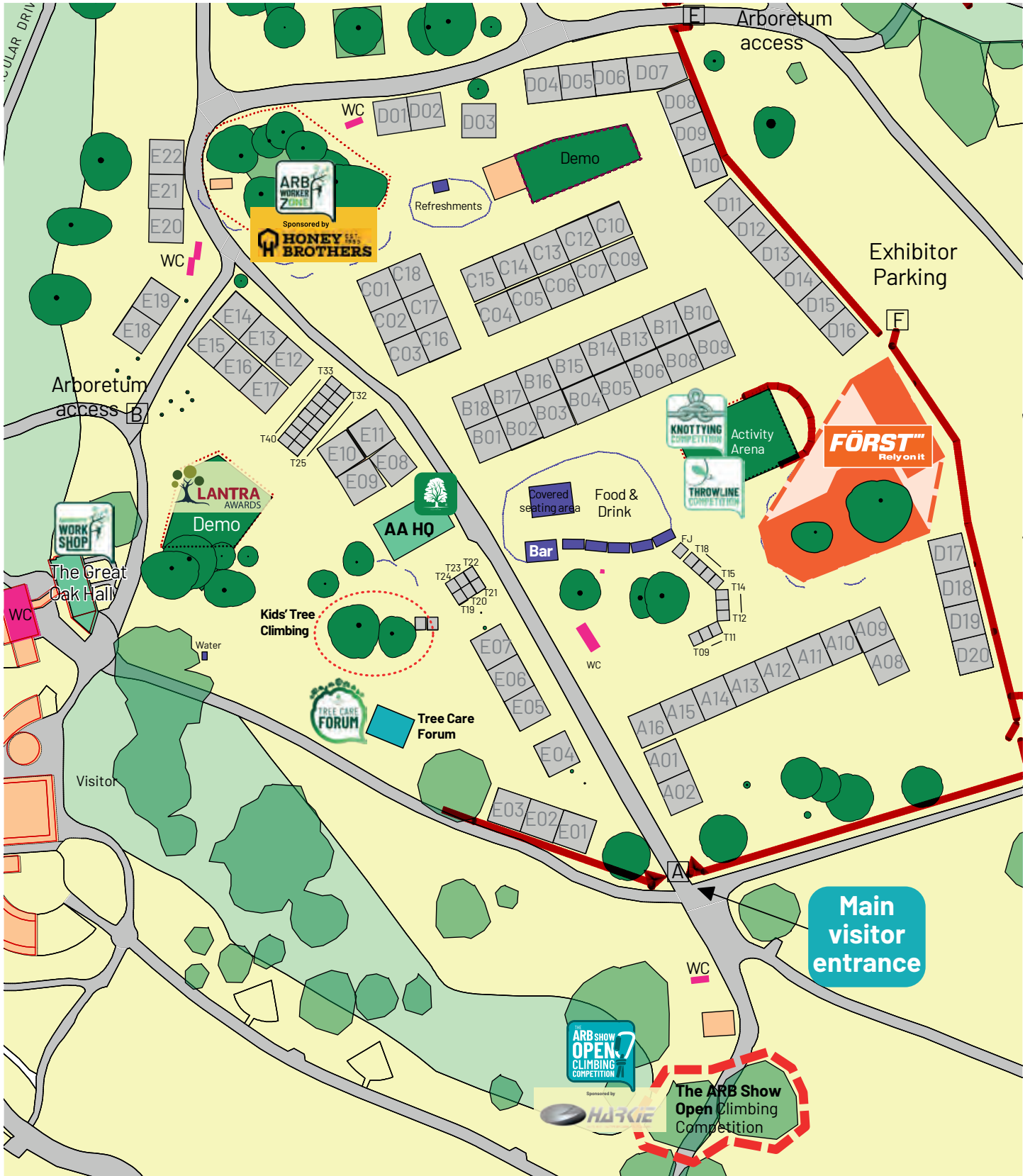

## PUBLIC OPENING TIMES (FRIDAY & SATURDAY)

Gates open at 9.00am.

Gates close at 5.00pm.

All visitors must vacate the showground by the closing time.

## GENERAL SAFETY

Arboricultural operations can be inherently hazardous, and care must be taken around exhibits, particularly when demonstrations are in progress.

- Obey all warning signs, notices and instructions from show staff and exhibitors.
- DO NOT** enter any taped off areas.
- DO NOT** enter demonstration areas.
- During demonstrations unless authorised to do so by demonstrating exhibitor at all times.
- The show site is uneven parkland. Please wear suitable footwear for the conditions and take care when walking around.
- Visitors **MUST** stay on the designated public areas and exhibitor strands.
- Take particular care when using mobility scooters or wheelchairs on the uneven ground.

## CHILDREN
