- 1. Name
- 2. Job title and organisation (if relevant)
- 3. Brief biography (no more than 100 words)
- 4. Title of session
- 5. Subject area
- 6. Abstract a summary of content of up to 300 words
- Proposed presentation type (e.g: Lecture theatre: PowerPoint, video, audio only; Outside: Practical workshop, demonstration, tour, etc, Poster session)



The deadline for proposals is **31 December 2018**. The AA's conference steering group will assess the proposals and we will aim to respond by the end of January 2019.
